

SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 26th, 2018

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof a special meeting was duly held in the Adams Health Care Center activities room on the 26th day of June, 2018 at 4:30 p.m.

Council present: Gail Anderson, Paul Kirtz, Nancy Thalberg, and Karen Ruechel.

Council absent: Peter Schmitz.

Mayor Nancy Thalberg presided at the meeting.

Mayor Thalberg presented a letter from the Health Care Center to the Adams police chief Mike Gehrke. The letter requested Mike's signature stating his department would respond to an emergency situation at the Health Care Center. Chief Gehrke was called into the meeting to review the request. Mike had not signed the letter stating that his department does not provide 24 hour coverage. Karen Ruechel advised Mike that he (or his deputies) would be expected to respond to an emergency in Adams even if he is not on duty. Karen advised Mike to call the Mower County Sherriff's office if he is out of town and cannot respond to an emergency. Mike signed the Health Care Center's letter requesting assistance in an emergency situation.

A brief discussion was held on who is responsible for dead or dangerous trees on resident's property. The City Clerk was directed to look into a tree policy for the City of Adams.

A motion was made by Gail Anderson, seconded by Karen Ruechel, to adjourn. Votes in favor: Gail Anderson, Karen Ruechel, and Paul Kirtz. Votes against: None. Motion carried
